

PRIVACY POLICY REGARDING PROCESSING AND THE USE OF PERSONAL DATA WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE DOCTORAL SCHOOL 'THE KLAGENFURT RESEARCH RETREAT' (KRR) 2026

Information obligation pursuant to Art. 13 DSGVO

Registration for and implementation of the Doctoral School KRR 2026

For the purpose of registration for and implementation of the Doctoral School KRR 2026, we process your personal data in accordance with the Call for Applications:

This data is processed on the basis of Art. 6 Abs. 1 lit. b DSGVO (contract performance/contract initiation). The personal data you provide is mandatory for the implementation and processing of the Doctoral School KRR (registration, communication, administration, documentation, archiving) and participation is not possible without it. The data will not be passed on to third parties outside the event organisation and the organising committee of the University of Klagenfurt. We store and process the data for the implementation and handling of the KRR 2026 and beyond, provided that this is legitimised by legal principles, e.g. storage of invoices in accordance with § 132 (1) BAO for 7 years.

For participants – registration with an account:

To apply within the event tool we use, you must create an account. Based on your consent in accordance with Art. 6 Abs. 1 lit. a DSGVO, we process your first name, last name, email address, user name and password.

We ask you to send us an application for the purpose of selection – see [Call for Applications](#). We use your personal data for the selection process, implementation and administration of the Doctoral School KRR 2026 (registration, communication, administration, documentation, archiving). This processing is based on Art. 6 Abs. 1 lit. a DSGVO (consent). This data will not be passed on directly to third parties outside the organisational unit and the organising

committee. Your application will be stored for a period of 10 years. If we do not select you, your application will be deleted.

You can revoke your consent at any time in writing (addressed to the office specified under "Responsible for data processing"). Otherwise, it is valid without time limitation. The revocation applies to all future publications, but not to those that have already been made.

Image, sound and video recordings during the face-to-face event

For documentation purposes, image, sound and video recordings will be made during the Doctoral School KRR 2026. The processing of this data is based on the legitimate interest of the University of Klagenfurt in effective press and public relations work to accompany the Doctoral School KRR 2026 and its documentation in accordance with Art. 6 Abs. 1 f DSGVO. The recordings are not intended to highlight individual persons and will be published in whole or in part in print media, on the Internet (e.g. on the homepage) and on social media platforms (e.g. Facebook, Instagram) managed by the University of Klagenfurt. Photos and videos will be deleted as soon as there is no longer a legitimate interest in presenting the respective event. This is the case, for example, if there is no longer any need to advertise this event because no follow-up event will be held.

Retention of declarations of consent

According to Art. 5 Abs. 2 DSGVO, every responsible person is obliged to be able to demonstrate compliance with all data protection principles (within the meaning of Art. 5 Abs. 1 DSGVO). Therefore, we process your declaration of consent on the basis of this accountability obligation for the purpose of proving that we have collected the data lawfully and are permitted to process it. We do not pass on your declaration of consent to third parties and process it for as long as we need it to prove the lawfulness of the processing, i.e. if measures by the supervisory authority or the assertion of claims for damages by a data subject are to be expected.

Rights of data subjects

You have the right to obtain information to check whether and which personal data we have stored about you, the right to correct your personal data that is incorrect, the right to delete your personal data that is not (or no longer) processed in accordance with the law, and, in this context, the right to restrict processing. You also have the right to data portability. If the processing is based on consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time without giving reasons. You have the right to have personal data deleted if you withdraw your consent on which the processing was based and there is no other legal basis for the processing. The lawfulness of the data processing up to the point of your withdrawal remains unaffected. Insofar as we base the processing of your personal data on overriding legitimate interests, you have the right to object.
